tale* (line 6) *n* a story, especially one which might be invented or difficult to believe 故事

throughout (line 6) *prep* in every part, or during the whole period of time 貫徹

pick up* (speech bubble 1) *phr v* (pick sth up) to learn interesting or useful information from someone or something 聞說

recently (speech bubble 1) *adv* not long ago, or at a time that started not long ago 最近

claim* (speech bubble 2) *v* to say that something is true or is a fact, although you cannot prove it and other people might not believe it 聲稱

sight* (speech bubble 2) *v* to suddenly see something or someone 目睹

night shift* (line 1) *n* a period of time at night, where a group of employees work in a factory, business, etc. 夜更

soak* (line 4) *v* to make very wet, or (of liquid) to be absorbed in large amounts 使濕透

pity (line 5) *n* a feeling of sympathy and understanding for someone else's unhappiness or difficult situation 憐憫

pull over* (line 6) *phr v* If a vehicle pulls over, it moves to the side of the road and stops 把...停到路旁

nod* (line 6) *v* to move one's head up and down, to show agreement or in acknowledgement 點頭

military (line 9) *adj* relating to or belonging to the armed forces 軍事的

compound (line 9) *n* an area surrounded by fences or walls which contains a group of buildings 大院

on duty (line 17) *idm* working and doing one's assigned duties 當值

roll (line 18) *n* a piece of film, paper or cloth that is rolled into the shape of a tube 卷

claim (line 22) *v* to ask for something of value because you think it belongs to you or because you think you have a right to it 認領

overjoyed (line 24) *adj* extremely pleased and happy 歡喜若狂

surgery (line 26) *n* the treatment of injuries or diseases in people or animals by cutting open the body and removing or repairing the damaged part 手術
